**ELIGIBILITY:**

**For all athletes and supporting staff coming from abroad it is mandatory to send via e-mail or bring with themselves the negative PCR test results on coronavirus not older than 48 hours before the competition dates.**

**ACCOMMODATION:**

The official Organizer's hotel is Hotel Pula\*\*\*, Address: Siplac ulica 31, Pula. The accommodation is not adopted for wheelchair users. The door specifications are as follows:

- elevator door width: 69 cm
- room door width: 70-71 cm
- bathroom door width: 60-61 cm
- all rooms are with the bathtub.

The second accommodation facility is Park Plaza Belvedere Medulin\*\*\*\*, Address: Osipovica 33, 52203 Medulin – limited number adopted rooms.

**TRANSPORT:**

The Organizers will not provide the transportation from the official hotel to the competition venue. The official hotel is very close to the competition venue (approx. 300 m). However, other accommodations, which are whc adopted, may vary in distances to the stadium.

**TRAVEL VISA AND TRAVEL REGULATIONS:**

It is the responsibility of all competitors and support staff to establish if a visa is required to enter the Croatia and to complete all necessary paperwork. Please check at the earliest opportunity by referring to the following website: [www.mvpei.hr](http://www.mvpei.hr). The Organizer's office can supply a help document with visa information and a written confirmation letter.

Due to the coronavirus measures, please refer to the recommendations and instructions for crossing the state border at the following link: <https://www.koronavirus.hr/recommendations-and-instructions-for-crossing-the-state-border/736> - It is the responsibility of the teams to plan their trip to Croatia accordingly above measures.

**MEDICAL SERVICES:**

During your visit to Pula, all team members must be covered by their own insurance policy for travel, liability, medical/dental treatment and for the cases of accidents, as well as potentially hospitalization due to coronavirus symptoms. The Stadium Medical Service will provide First Aid to the athletes during the competition. The Stadium medical staffs are also responsible for the first aid in the warning-up area during the competition.

**TEAM MANAGERS TECHNICAL MEETING:**

Due to epidemic situation (as for Covid-19) there will not be Technical Meeting as usual. All technical information will be sent via e-mail to the Team leaders and will be published at the

web site: [www.hasosi.hr](http://www.hasosi.hr). If there are any withdrawals, please send us the information as soon as possible in order to regulate the start lists and to make sure the competition schedule is as accurate as it can be. Number bibs will be distributed at the Hotel Pula (lobby) on Saturday March 27<sup>th</sup> from 16:00h onwards. In case of needs for any additional communication in relation of technical matters, after the technical manuals for the Team Leaders have been circulated, please do not hesitate to communicate with us accordingly.

#### **COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

Competition will be held under the Croatian national regulations, as follows:

- If 5 (or more) athletes of one sport class are presented, that will be a single class event (*the Organizer reserve the right to make changes to this rule if that would have a positive impact to the quality and rhythm of the competition*),
- In all other cases, we will try to combine the groups and Raza point system will be used to determine placings,
- The final event program and class combinations will be determined along with the Technical delegate,
- Due to epidemic situation and suggestions to avoid any unnecessary ceremonies (gathering) at the competition, the medals for first three athletes from the event will be given only for Croatian athletes, as this is national championships. All athletes from abroad will get the medal of participation together with the bib number.
- Max. 2 (two) event per athlete.

#### **ANTI-DOPING:**

Doping control will be present and run under jurisdiction of HADA – national anti-doping organization. Athletes are not allowed to take or carry with them any substances that are included on the WADA Prohibited List. Athletes who are found to have violated this rule shall be held individually responsible for their action. Athletes who are taking medication from the (most recent) WADA Prohibited List for therapeutic reasons will need a copy of their Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) for any generally prohibited substance.

#### **COVID-19 MEASURED:**

- Wearing masks in all indoor areas (including Call Room) is mandatory.
- Body temperature will be measured at the entrance to the Call Room.
- We strongly suggests all the athletes, as well as their coaches and other supporting staff to maintain the appropriate distance of at least 1,5 m (where possible), in every situation including but not limited to field of play, Call Room, Warm up area, hotel accommodation etc, in order to avoid any possible spread of coronavirus infection.
- Try to wash and disinfect your hands as much as possible.
- The athletes, and any other supporting staff, are strongly advised to avoid social contact in the rooms when in hotel. Make your social activities at the outdoors.
- When in the hotel restaurant, try not to stay to long and avoid contact with other guests.
- At the field of play, do not gather with the large group, try taking care of the appropriate distance and positioning your athlete kit away from others (if possible).
- Drink exclusively from your bottles.
- If you have any, use your own implement.
- Do not hug each other, shaking hands or kissing with other athletes in order to celebrate the achievement.
- In case you feel any symptoms related to Covid-19 diseases, inform the official medical staff immediately.

The assistant will be given an assistant/guide vest to enter the stadium together with the athlete.*
